Regarding the Dispute Settlement Committee, the Supreme Council of Judicial Power appointed on December 5, 2018 Mr. Essaid SAADAoui, President of Chamber at the Court of Cassation as the President of this Committee, in accordance with the provisions of the above-mentioned law 48-15.

Eventually, it should be mentioned that the mission of ANRE will be in accordance with the application of the provisions of law n°48-15 relating to the regulation of the electricity sector and the creation of the National Electricity Regulatory Authority to accompany the transformations that the renewable energy sector has undergone, in order to (i) increase its attractiveness, strengthen the confidence of donors, investors and industrial entities, (ii) ensure competition and transparency in the electricity sector, and (iii) facilitate Morocco's integration into the Mediterranean electricity market. ANRE will also work at setting the tariff for use of the national electricity transmission grid and the tariff for use of the medium-voltage electricity distribution networks.

In addition, ANRE approves the multi-year investment program of the national electricity transmission system operator. It also approves the code of the national electricity transmission system, which sets, in a non-discriminatory manner, the technical prescriptions concerning the conditions of connection and access to the national electricity transmission system, including interconnections, as well as the rules relating to the use of the said system.

On the other hand, ANRE has the power to sanction and settle disputes. Sanctions are imposed by decision of the President of ANRE with the assent of the Dispute Settlement Committee.
